

La Trobe University

Campuses: Melbourne, Bendigo, Mildura, Shepparton, Albury-Wodonga.

Aspire Early Admissions Program

Aspire rewards the skills and knowledge you've gained through your community contribution with a conditional early offer into your chosen course at La Trobe.

Applications are now open and close on 31 August.

Achieve at La Trobe

You can study a free online university subject through La Trobe.

La Trobe will use the grade you achieve to create a La Trobe entrance score. They will use this score if it's higher than your ATAR.

Prepare for La Trobe

This pathway is ideal for VCAL students and VCE students who are undertaking a non-scored pathway this year.

You will study online 'micro subjects' and La Trobe will use the grades you achieve to create a La Trobe entrance score.

The subjects are free.

Monash University

Monash Guarantee

Campuses: Clayton, Peninsula, Caulfield, Parkville.

The Monash Guarantee can get you into a Monash course even if you don't reach the course's lowest selection rank. You could be eligible for the Monash Guarantee if you:

- Have experienced financial disadvantage.
- Live in a low socio-economic area.
- Attend a Monash list under-represented school.
- Are an Indigenous Australian.

To receive a guaranteed offer, you will need to achieve the guaranteed minimum ATAR set by the University, meet eligibility criteria for your course, and place the course as your highest preference on VTAC.

- Apply for the course/s via VTAC between 3 August - 30 September, www.vtac.edu.au
- Fill out the relevant SEAS category via VTAC – Personal Information and Location and/or Disadvantaged Financial Circumstances between 3 August – 9 October, <https://bit.ly/3bfMeC4>

The University of Melbourne

Access Melbourne

Campus: Parkville.

You may receive a guaranteed place in your desired course with a lower ATAR set by the University if you're eligible for Access Melbourne under the categories of:

- Disadvantaged financial background.
- Live in a rural or isolated area.
- Indigenous Australian.

To receive a guaranteed offer, you will need to achieve the guaranteed minimum ATAR set by the University, meet eligibility criteria for your course, and place the course as your highest preference on VTAC.

Application Process

- Apply for the course/s via VTAC between 3 August - 30 September, www.vtac.edu.au
- Fill out the relevant SEAS category via VTAC – Personal Information and Location and/or Disadvantaged Financial Circumstances between 3 August – 9 October, <https://bit.ly/3bfMeC4>

Campuses: Melbourne and Ballarat.

Community Achievers Program

The Community Achiever Program (CAP) is open to people who volunteer for local community, social justice, sporting or cultural causes. In return, you may gain early entry and tap into leadership and development opportunities.

ACU Guarantee

Offers will be made based on your Year 11 results and you may receive an offer before your Year 12 exams. You can choose to supply a brief statement outlining your personal circumstances and motivation for university study, which may help improve your selection rank.

Passion for Business

Students can receive an early guaranteed offer for one of seven eligible single or combined Bachelor degrees in areas such as business, IT, and commerce. You must be studying a business-related subject at school, <http://bit.ly/2beXyl2>

Passion for Law

Students can receive an early guaranteed offer for the Bachelor of Law combined with one of eight Bachelor degrees such as Global Studies, Commerce, Arts, Psychological Science and Biomedical Science, <http://bit.ly/2bp4UUM>

Swinburne University

Swinburne University Early Entry Program

Campus: Hawthorn

Offers will be made based on a recommendation from your school and will be 'ATAR free'.

You will still need to complete year 12 and meet subject prerequisites, but in the words of Swinburne, *'this isn't an easy way out, it's a determined person's way forward'*.

Application Process

Step 1: check that your course is eligible and that you meet the subject prerequisites.

Step 2: if your school is willing to support your application, you will both fill out the recommendation form.

Step 3: add the Swinburne course/s to your VTAC preference list.

If your school agrees to recommend you and if you achieve a minimum English study score of 20 (higher for EAL), meet other subject prerequisites and complete year 12, you will receive a guaranteed offer.

Applications for Round 1 are open between 3 August – 28 August. You will need to create a VTAC account before you can apply as you will need your VTAC ID number.



Charles Sturt University

Charles Sturt Advantage

Campus: Albury-Wodonga

Charles Sturt Advantage takes into consideration your ATAR plus your 'soft skills'.

When you apply for entry to Charles Sturt via Charles Sturt Advantage, all you need to do is demonstrate how you've displayed resilience, empathy and a commitment to creating a world worth living in (like your motivation to study your chosen degree).

If you receive a place in the program, you will be eligible for a guaranteed place in your desired course providing you:

- Achieve the required minimum ATAR set by the University
- Meet eligibility criteria for the course.
- Place the course as your highest preference through VTAC or UAC.

Application process:

- Apply for the course/s via VTAC or UAC between 3 August - 30 September.
- Apply for the Advantage program direct to Charles Sturt University between 1 June - 31 August.

Victoria University

VU Guaranteed

Campuses: 10 campuses across Victoria.

The VU Guaranteed program offers Year 11 and 12 students from partnership schools a guaranteed place at Victoria University (VU) or Victoria University Polytechnic (VU Polytechnic), prior to their final Year 12 exams.

Benefits include:

- Eligible applicants will receive an additional 5 ATAR points towards their final selection rank for selected courses that require an ATAR.
- Access to exclusive VU Guaranteed events
- Tailored course advice on your study options.
- You may receive a scholarship.

- Apply for VU Guaranteed by Friday 9 October direct to the University.

RMIT University

Schools Network Access Program (SNAP)

Campuses: City, Bundoora, Brunswick.

The SNAP access scheme is designed to increase tertiary access and participation of eligible students from SNAP partner schools by giving them priority access to RMIT's certificate IV, diploma, advanced diploma, associate degree and degree courses.

How it works

To receive SNAP consideration for a given course, applicants must have an ATAR that is within 20 points of the lowest selection rank (including adjustments) for that course. Depending on the applicant's initial ATAR and the competitiveness of the course, this may deem them eligible for an offer.

For courses that select on a range of criteria such as folio or interview, SNAP applicants receive equivalent consideration on their performance in these tasks.

For entry to bachelor degree courses, the minimum English study score for SNAP applicants is 5 points lower than the published English study score.

University of Tasmania

Schools Recommendation Scheme

The School's Recommendation Program will ensure that you are not disadvantaged by any challenges you face this year.

It has been designed to give you confidence in completing year 12 and receiving a university place in 2021.

This means that, no matter what happens, we have a place for you at the University of Tasmania.

You'll be able to choose from a range of exciting, diverse courses that will prepare you for a successful career.

Note: At this stage, the program cannot guarantee places for quota courses such as Medicine, Nursing or Paramedicine.

Application process:

- Review the list of available courses - <https://bit.ly/2yaNvNc>
- Submit your application for the program direct to the University. Applications close 30 November, but offers will be made before then, so apply ASAP.
- Your school will complete the recommendation and supply your year 11 results.
- You will receive an offer once the recommendation is received from your school.
